As the dispatching assignment location you undertake to ensure the following:

- The volunteer will be given extensive information on the type and scope of the secondment and consents to the secondment. The volunteer's consent must be obtained in writing and filed by the assignment location.
- The volunteer's assignment will take place only in areas focussed on the common good, <u>not</u> for commercially active subcontractors such as surveillance, catering or cleaning services.
- The assignment location's obligations to the volunteer from the Volunteer Agreement continue to apply.
- The volunteer will be fully insured also when working at the place of secondment.
- Any special preventive measures required for work at the place of secondment (e.g. vaccinations) will be organised and the associated costs will be paid.
- The volunteer will continue to receive pedagogical support from the dispatching assignment location.

C Declaration by the assignment location

- 1. The educational and support measures required shall be implemented in accordance with Section 18 of the Federal Volunteer Service Act (BFDG) and the "Framework Directive for Pedagogical Support in the Federal Volunteer Service under Special Consideration of Seminar Work and the Personnel Used" ("Rahmenrichtlinie für die pädagogische Begleitung im Bundesfreiwilligendienst (BFD) unter besonderer Berücksichtigung der Seminararbeit und des dabei eingesetzten Personals"). The quality and scope of the pedagogical support in the Federal Volunteer Service pertaining to Refugees shall comply with the high standards of the educational days provided under the regular Federal Volunteer Service.
- 2. A separate declaration stating the details of pedagogical support shall be submitted in writing to the competent central office at the latest three weeks after the volunteer's start of service.
- 3. The information sheet of the BAFzA on the Federal Volunteer Service and the information sheet on the special programme of the Federal Volunteer Service pertaining to refugees have been provided to the volunteer and s/he has acknowledged the same.
