THE PROJECT

The OECD Policy Dialogue on DDC in Germany is providing support to the German federal government, states and municipalities to increase the effectiveness, efficiency, and impact of their DDC programmes through the following three main actions:

1. Improving the impact of German DDC policies, strategies and programmes, including ODA monitoring;
2. Strengthening the multi-level governance of DDC in Germany;
3. Promoting capacity-building and peer-to-peer learning.

So far, the OECD has carried out two surveys and several bilateral interviews with representatives of German central government, federal states, municipalities and other stakeholders to collect data, evidence and practices on DDC activities. The OECD has also organised two capacity building workshops to discuss and further develop the OECD findings from the survey and interviews as well as promote peer-to-peer learning with cities, regions and national governments from other OECD countries.

This third workshop will bring together key stakeholders from municipalities, states and federal government in Germany, with the main aim of presenting the draft OECD report, finalising the recommendations, and defining concrete actions to implement them. The workshop, report and recommendations aim to identify ways forward to reshape decentralised development co-operation and to contribute data, evidence and best practices to feature in the Global Policy Toolkit.

OBJECTIVES OF THE THIRD WORKSHOP

- **Present** the draft OECD Report on DDC in Germany;
- **Consolidate** the policy recommendations;
- **Design** the action plan for the implementation of the policy recommendations;
- **Promote** a peer-to-peer exchange of knowledge with international peer reviewers;
- **Discuss** the draft Global Policy Toolkit to upscale DDC effectiveness, efficiency and impact.
